Jewish Canadians looking to keep track of the lives and deaths of old friends now have assistance in the latter pursuit with the launching of JewishPassings.com.

The website publishes a free daily e-newsletter informing subscribers of the most recent deaths in the Toronto Jewish Community.

According to site founder Marlene Kohn, "The idea came out of a personal experience when my friend's father passed away while I was on vacation and I had no knowledge of it. Had there been an email sent, I would have been able to pay respects at the appropriate time since I was checking emails on a regular basis."

While the announcements are geared to the Toronto Jewish community, the listings occasionally includes announcements from other cities, due to the large ex-pat community of Toronto, particularly from Montreal and Winnipeg, whose members still have family in these cities.
